- Streetwear** A versatile daytime outfit with strong directional modern look.
- Avant-garde** A garment that delights in the unconventional and unexpected.
- Machine-Crafted** - Designs created using machinery to knit, weave or sew. The garment is created with the use of the machine, not by hand crafting.
- Special Occasion** A glamorous outfit that speaks confidence and quality and takes presentation to higher levels of sophistication.
- Collections** Three complete cohesive looks with a common design theme.
- Hand-crafted** Hand-knitted, crocheted, felted, woven, needlepoint: innovative use of any of these hand-crafted techniques. No machine knits.
- Accessories** Design and hand-crafted shoes, jewellery, scarves, capes, wraps or headwear.
- Sustainable Wool** Garments designed and created using recycled or repurposed wool
- Toi Tu ki Uruuruwhenua** Drawing inspiration from culture across Aotearoa New Zealand including Te Ao Māori, that may involve traditional handcraft techniques and / or symbolism.
- Pink Wool Plaster Challenge** create something unusual with the use of donated pink wool plasters.

All items in the package must be labelled with your entry code. Sticky tape is no longer acceptable except when attaching to hard surface ie shoes/accessories. Tape peels off the garments during wear.
